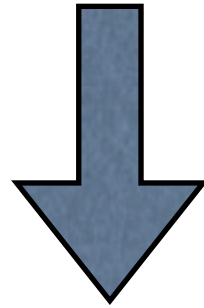

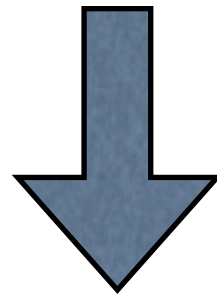

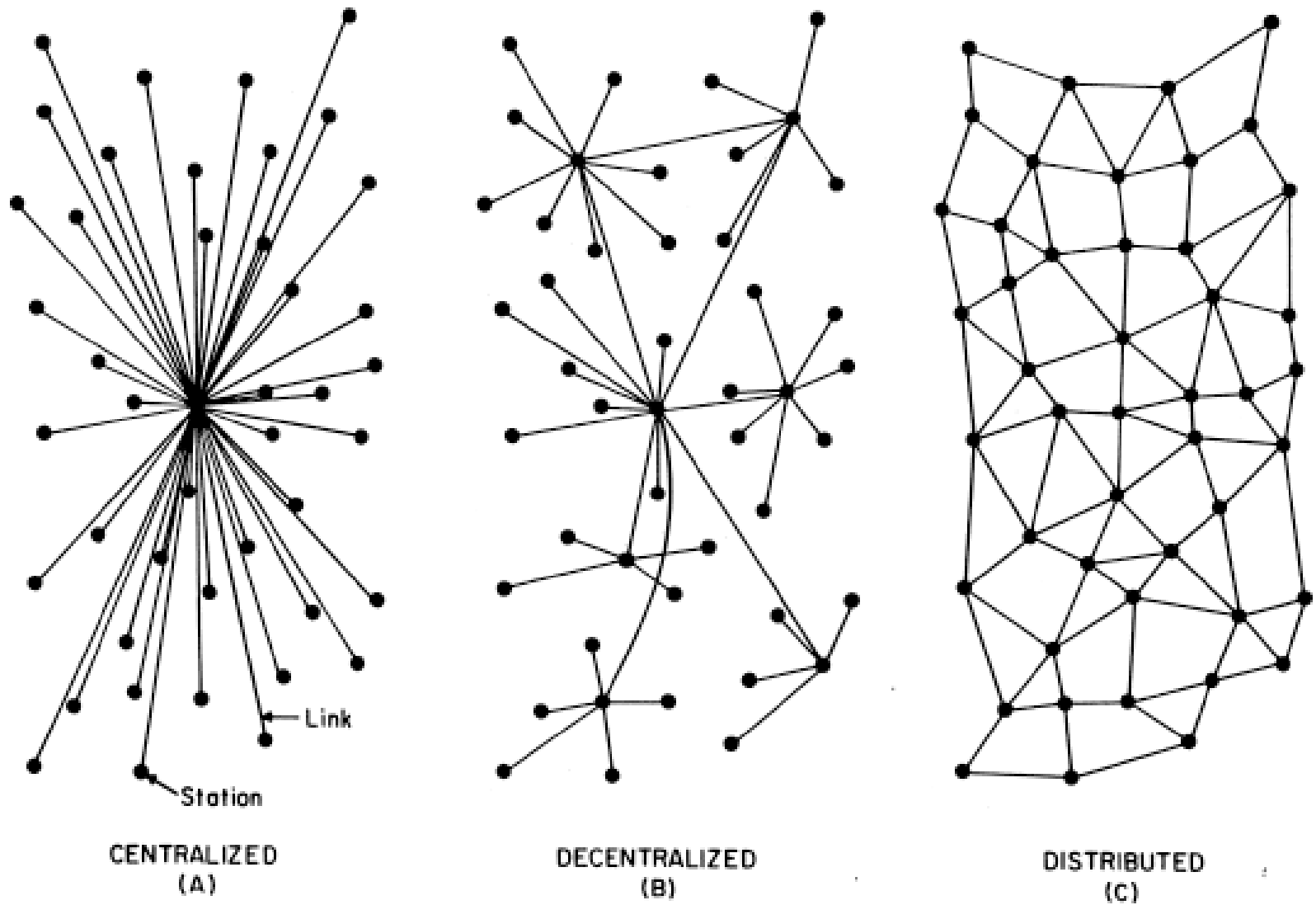


FIG. 1 – Centralized, Decentralized and Distributed Networks
